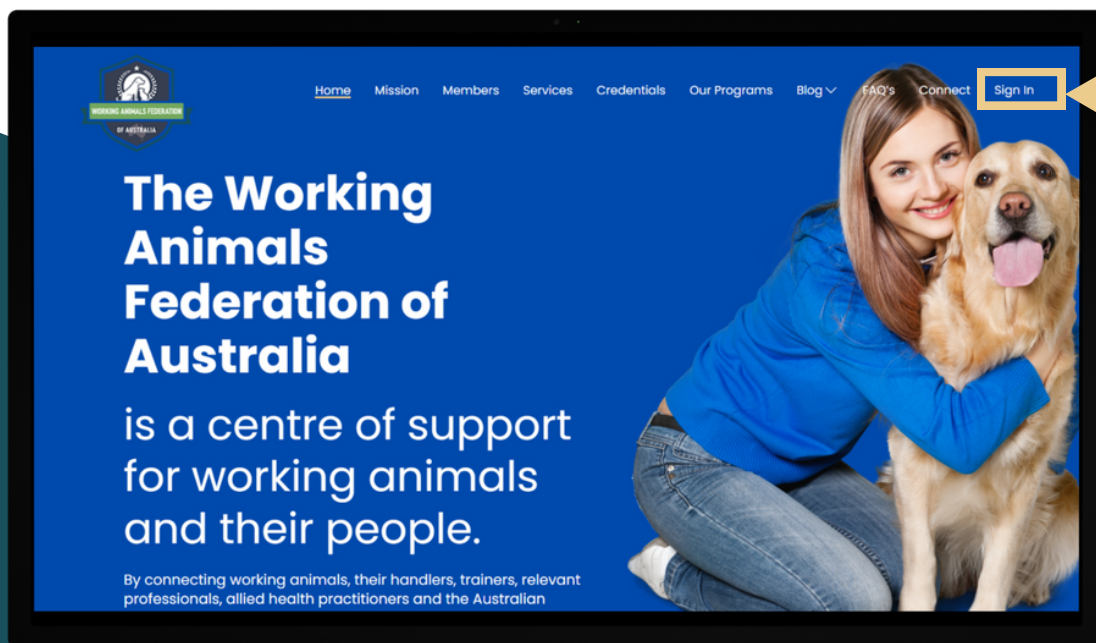




How to Locate and Enroll in the WAFA Assistance Animal Ambassador Course

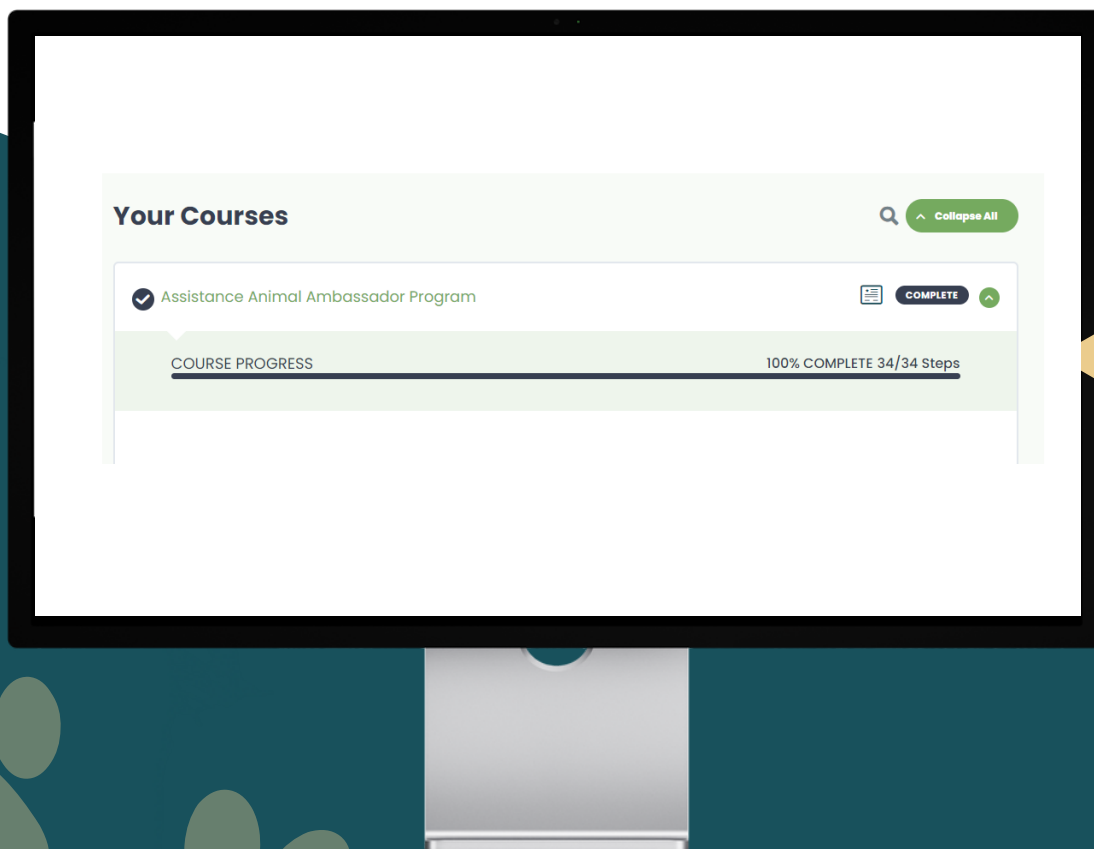
